Security Officer (SO) ≥\$1,175

Duties:

General screening; Guarding & Patrolling; Access & Egress Control; Basic Incident Response

To qualify as an SO: Complete the 2 mandatory *BLUs below

- Handle security incidents and services
- Provide guard and patrol services

Senior Security Officer (SSO) ≥\$1,360

Duties:

Incident Response; Manage Security & Safety Systems; Regulate Traffic (Road Traffic Act); Monitor CCTV/ Central Alarm/ Fire Command Centre; Assist State/Auxiliary Police in Law Enforcement; Key Press Management

To qualify as an SSO:

6 months experience as a SO + 2 mandatory Cert level modules below

- Manage disorderly conduct and threatening behaviour
- Operate basic security equipment

Security Supervisor (SS) ≥\$1,560

Duties:

Incident Management & Reporting; Direct Supervision; Execute Evacuation Plans & Exercises

To qualify as an SS:

12 months experienceas as a SSO + 1 mandatory **ALU + any 2 of the 3 Adv Cert level recommended modules below)

- Supervise security officers
- Assess and address security risks[^]
- Induct security personnel^
- Perform supervisory duties within legal framework[^]

Senior Security Supervisor (SSS) ≥\$1,760

Duties:

In-Charge of CCTV Centre/ Central Alarm Monitoring Centre/ Fire Command Centre; Conduct Security & Risk Assessment; Higher Supervision

To qualify as an SSS:

1 year 6 months experience as a SS + 4 Adv Cert level modules (i.e. 1 mandatory module + any 3 of the 6 recommended modules below)

- Monitor and review security operations
- Conduct operation briefing and debriefing
- Lead and manage a team of security officers
- Perform monitoring and reporting duties at central command centre
- Deploy security equipment
- Contribute to the management of security incidents
- Supervise crowd and traffic control activities

- Requirements:
- Singapore Citizen, Singapore Permanent Resident and Malaysian Work Permit Holder
- Malaysian Work Permit Holders: to submit scanned copy of your Malaysian identity card, passport, Certificate of Good Conduct (CGC) (not more than 3 months from date of issue) and Work Permit within 5 working days.
- Application fee of \$16

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



Additional Courses Required for Specific Tasks:

- WSQ Conduct Security Screening of Person and Bag and WSQ Conduct Security Screening Using X-Ray Machine courses will be compulsory for security personnel whose deployment involves the respective screening activities.
- The WSQ Handle Counter-Terrorism Activities course will also be compulsory for security personnel that are deployed at any protected area or protected place within the meaning of the Protected Areas and Protected Places Act (Cap 256)
